### Front Line Volunteers

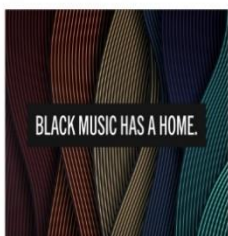
Front Line Volunteers support museum operations by providing general assistance to guests while working in high-traffic, public spaces, galleries, and exhibits.
