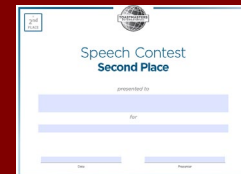
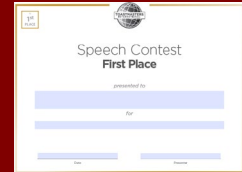

CONTEST INFORMATION

Contestant Advancement

- Area Contests: Clubs will be allowed to send the top 2 contestants to the Area Contest as long as that Area has 4 or less clubs in good standing 8 weeks prior to the competition.
- Division Contest: Each Division has 4 areas in it. The top 2 contestants from the Area Contest will be able to advance to the Division Contest.
- District Contest: Due to constraints to the Spring Conference schedule, only the 1st place winner from each Division (or the next highest contestant from that Division if the 1st place is unable to compete) will advance to the District Contest at Spring Conference.

Accomplish this goal and you'll qualify to receive a Smedley Award ribbon, named in honor of Ralph Smedley, which you can display on your club's banner.
